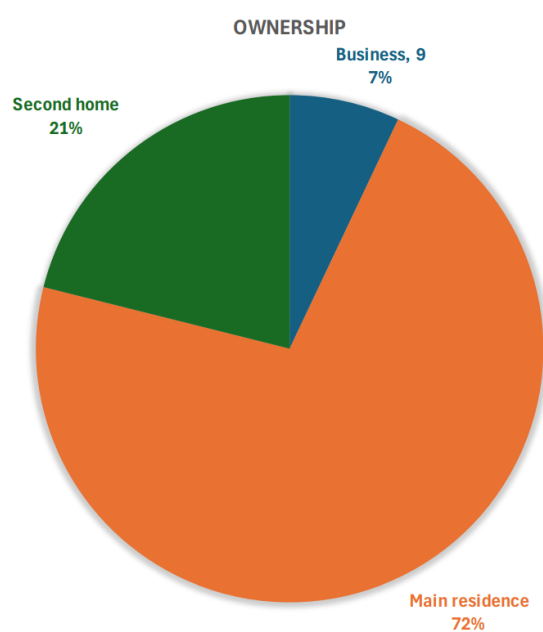
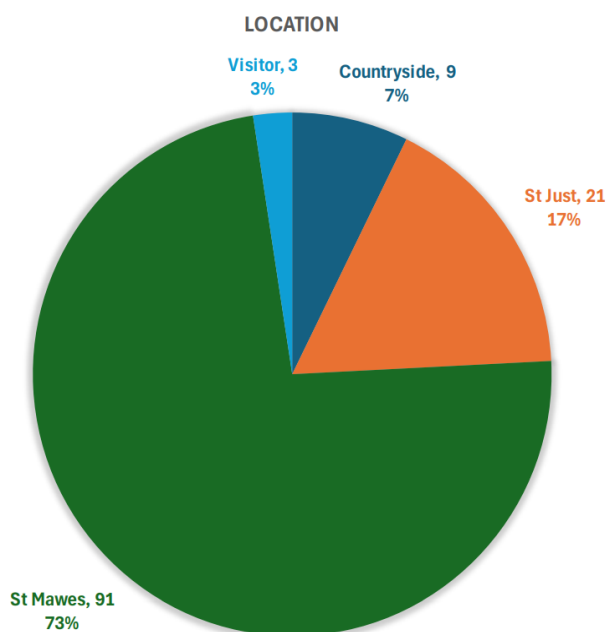
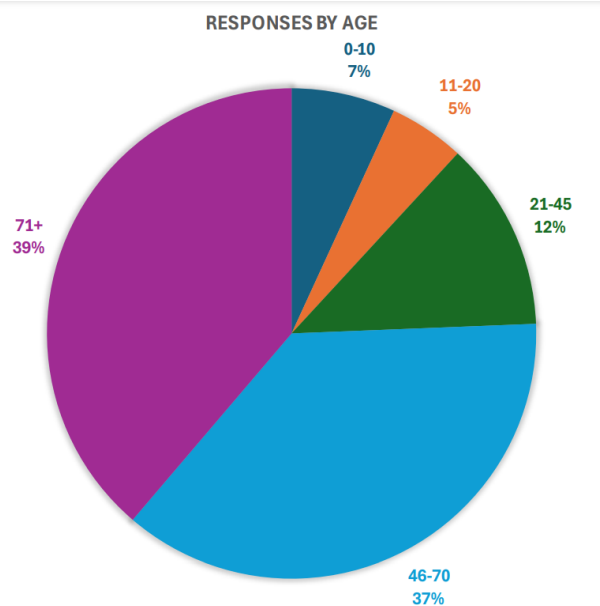


STAGE 1 SURVEY RESULTS - OVERVIEW

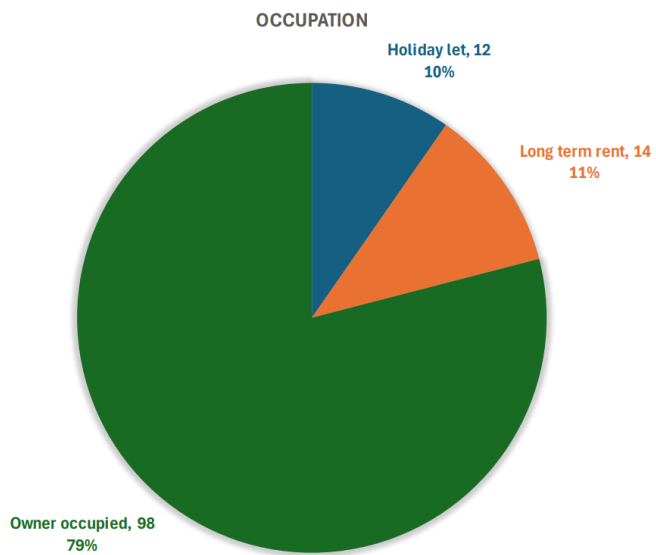
- 920 forms distributed: 131 replies.
- Stage 1 Response was 14%.
- ‘Membership’ organisations’ survey expected response rate is 10-30% - we are in the ‘expected’ range.
- Distribution of replies shown in pie charts below. Compared with the ‘actual’ population and ownership balance, appears better response rate from: St Mawes and ‘Main Residences’.



- Nature of occupation. Pie chart below indicates better response rate from:
 - o Owner Occupiers (2021 Census: 68% owner outright or with a mortgage) than from
 - o Long Term Rent (2021 Census: 18% Socially Rented) and
 - o Holiday Let (2021 Census: 14% Privately Rented).

Although the comparisons are not an exact match, the survey results are not a surprise as one might expect a better response rate from Owner Occupiers who may feel they have more ‘skin in the game’.

- The age profile of responses shows a 10% higher than Census figure for over 70 (29%) and 10% lower for 20-44 (22%) (other age groups within 1% of Census figures)



- Overall Conclusion. The responses appear to offer a fair reflection of the categories of people and properties in the Parish.
