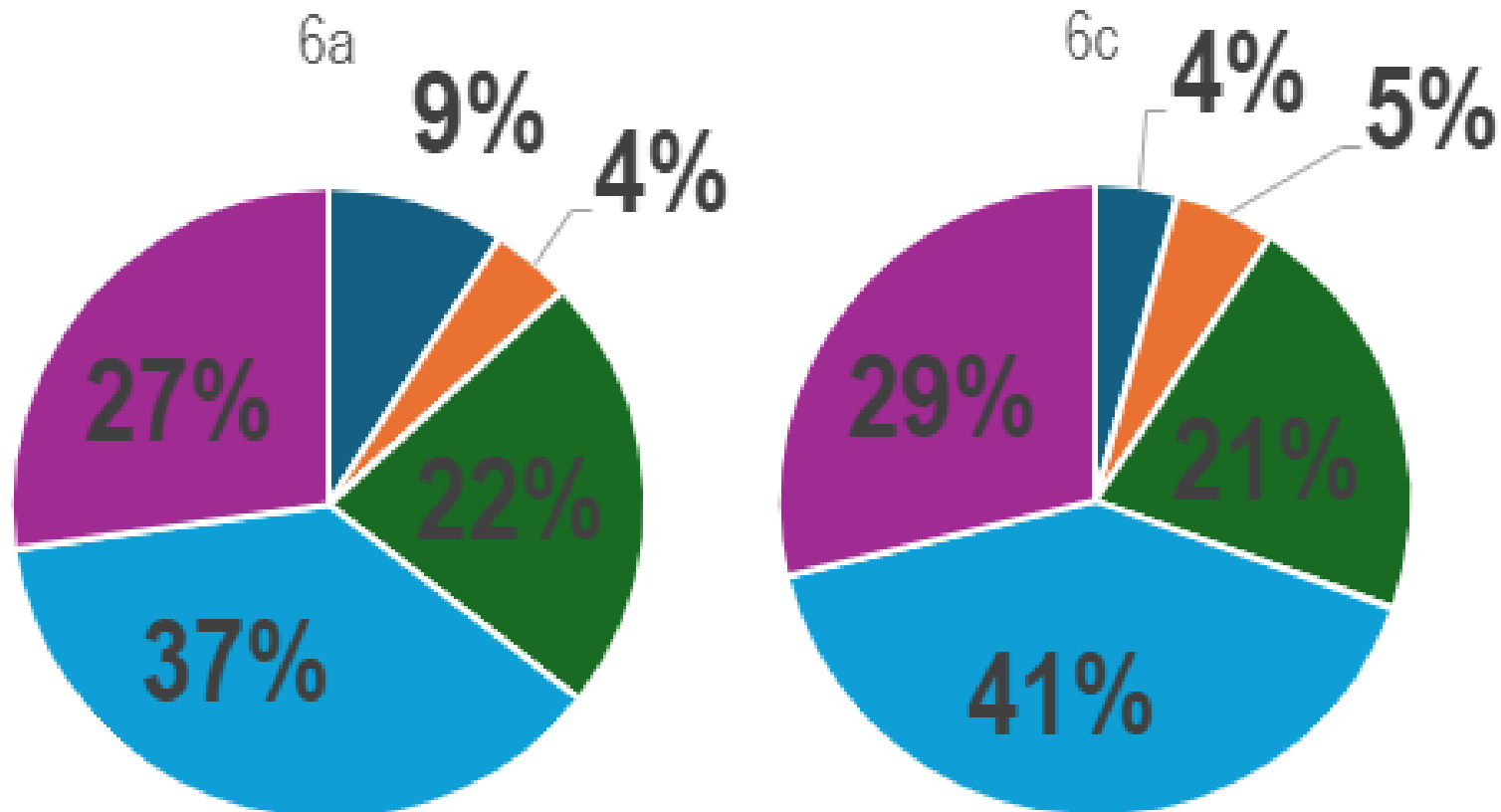

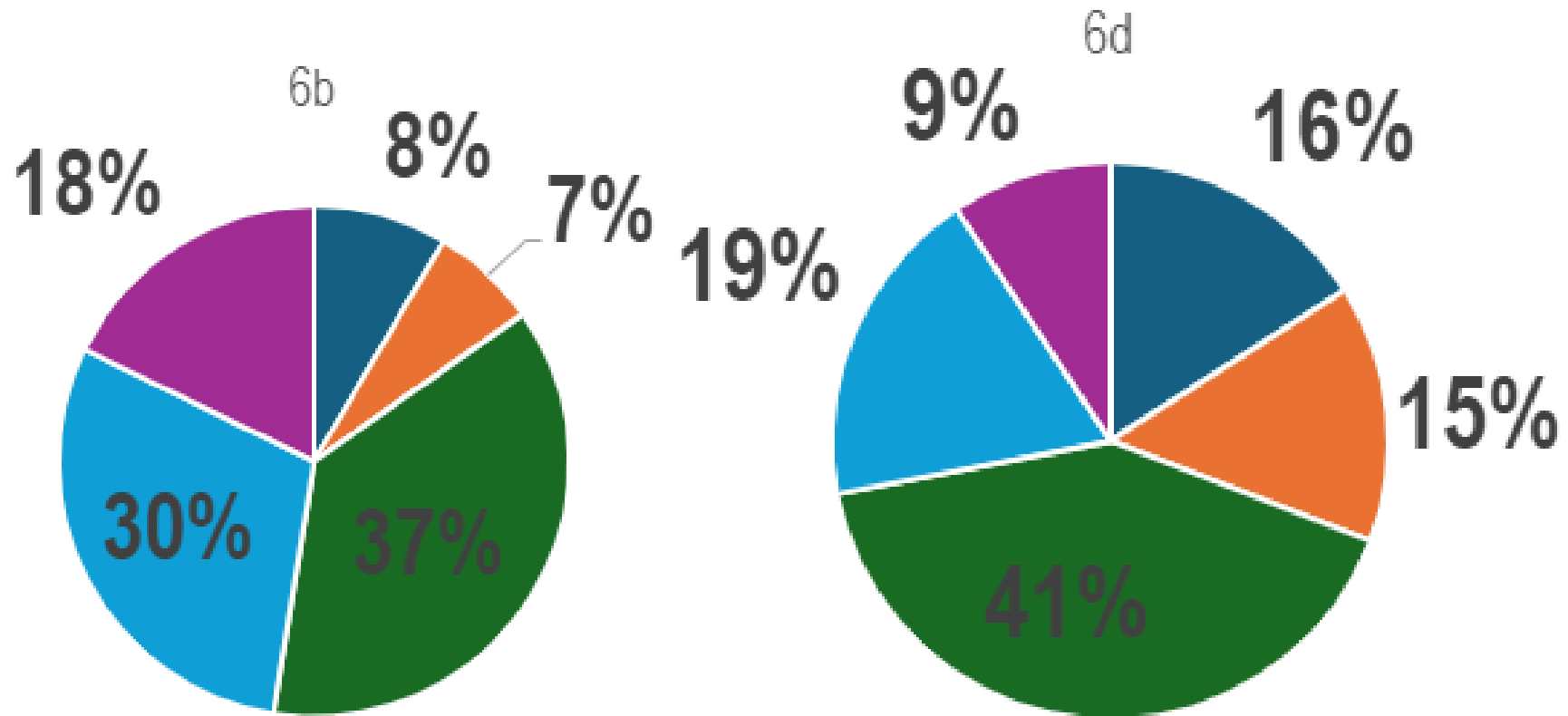

STAGE 2 CONSULTATION

Proposal 1 - Environmental Policy Resolution

The Parish Council should pass the following resolution:

The Parish Council adopts a policy that it and every sub-committee should, in all their work, give explicit consideration to the environmental and ecological impact of their decisions

Proposal 2 – Form an Environmental Group

The term ‘Environment’ includes:

- Natural environment - all ecological factors on which the health of the region depends - streams, rivers, seabed, cliffs, open spaces etc *and wildlife*
- Manmade landscape - farms, roads, verges, open spaces, etc
- Urban landscape - street furniture such as bins benches, signs and similar artefacts

The Group would be acting in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Some may join on these grounds, rather than climate change.
