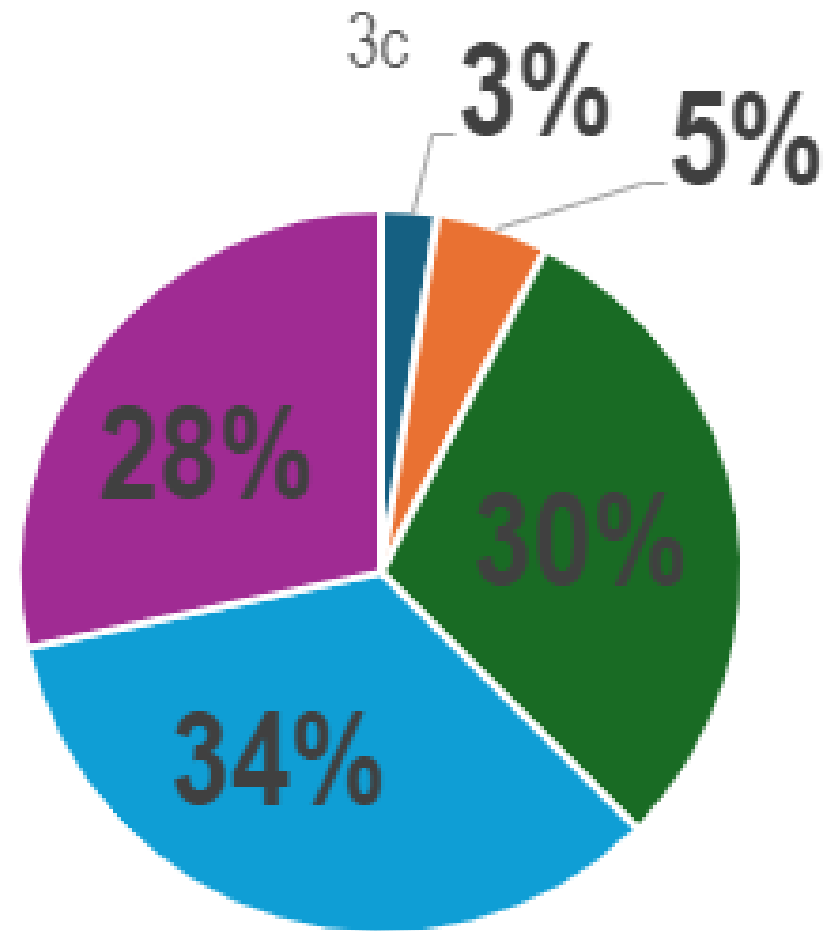
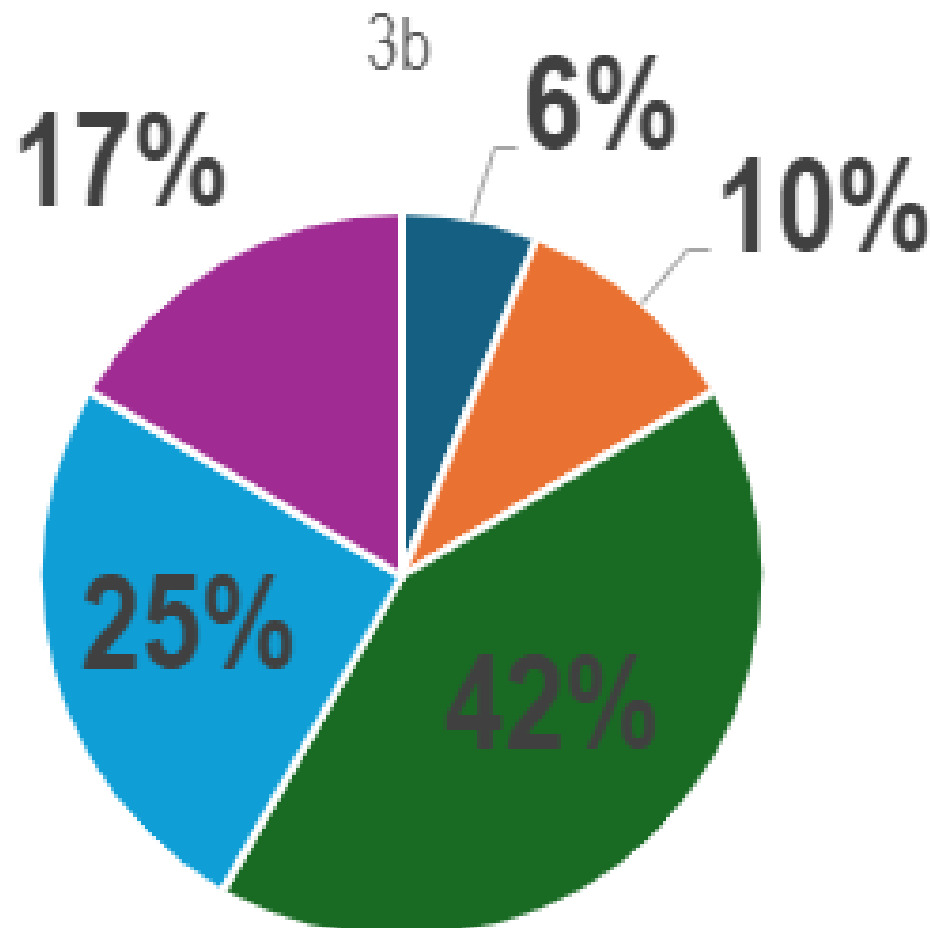
We asked: (3a) Should more be done to 'promote & retain' the shops we still have?

(3e) Do you care enough about shops in St Mawes to alter your shopping habits? You said:

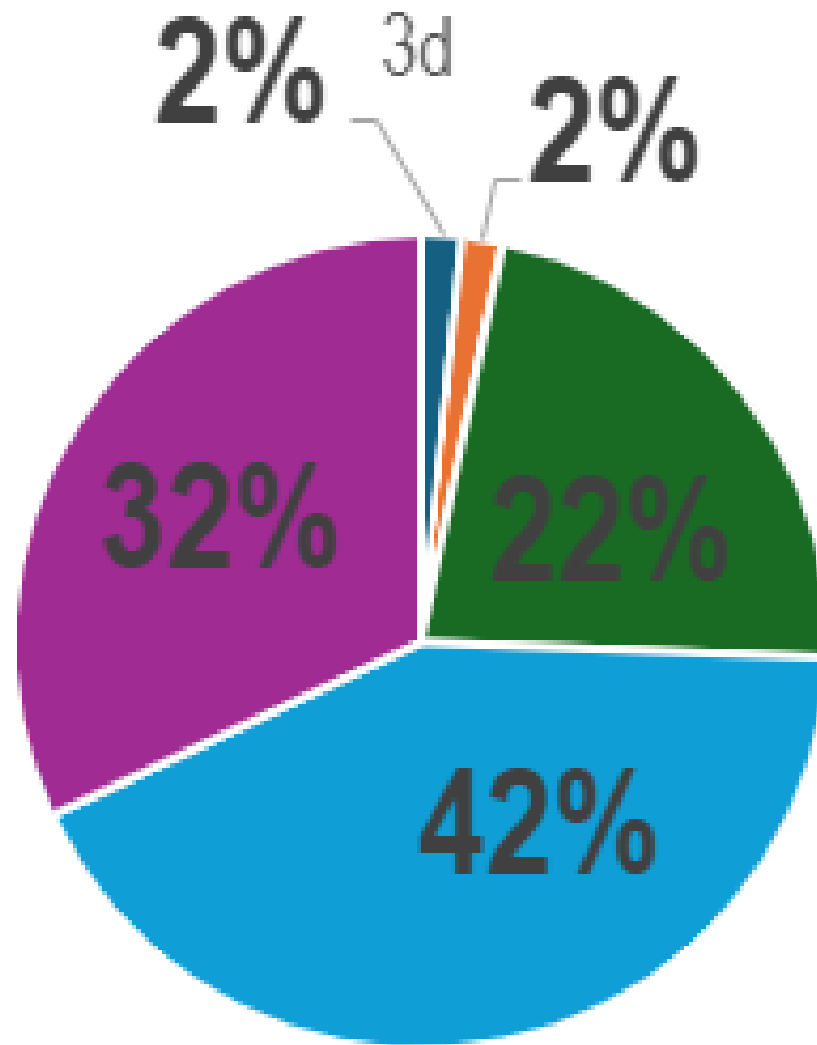


We asked: (3b) Is a 'local logo/sticker' for use in shop windows (and private homes) a good idea?
