St Just Lane Car Park - no issues

The Car Park needs a good clean up in the winter. Clerk to organise for the 2nd week of January for the trees to be cut, the car park swept and then tarmacked.

6. Parking in the Parish

Clerk reported that Cornwall Council are about to start discussions with us about the Feasibility Study and a date is imminent.

A discussion took place about parking on the roads in St Just in Roseland but it was felt that this should continue to be monitored.

7. St Mawes and St Just in Roseland Toilets

St Just Toilets still need flooring to be completed, clerk to arrange contractor to complete this work, the paint has already been purchased.

Clerk updated that there was vandalism in the Gents Toilets with a hole being made which has been repaired by Cllr Giles and Salter. Clerk to check if the CCTV could be moved to a different location to cover the toilets, alternatively the cost for an extra camera.

8. Any other business

Cllr Giles updated that the Gig Club had commenced preparation work at the top overflow car park and it was agreed that the drain must stay in position and that a retaining wall is required.
