**5. St Mawes and St Just in Roseland Car Park**

St Mawes

It was noted that considerable repairs would need to be undertaken once the season is over. The entrance to the car park is undulating and the surface down from the middle of the car park to the entrance damaged by the frequent water leaks. Much of the lining will need redoing, including the yellow hatching.

The new car park machines, installed in April, are performing very well, with the ease of use being remarked on by members of the public.

St Just in Roseland

No concerns noted, apart from the need to keep the hedge trimmed back.

**6. Note the car park takings for March to May and split of cash and card payments**

The Clerk provided a tariff use report for the new machines, which showed that from March to May, the two hour time slot was the most used. It was noted that cash payments account for only 7% of the revenue.

Electric Charging Points in St Mawes Car Park

Cornwall Council have now received approval from the Department for Transport under the Local Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Fund and are moving into the next stage of delivery.

Site surveys will begin shortly, prioritising locations, such as ours where parishes have already expressed interest. The survey should hopefully be completed by the end of September.
